In addition to the work and other relevant experience provided as Appendix B with the original application submittal, CSA Planning, Ltd. offers this addendum as a supplement of work and related experience for Jay Harland relevant to the proposed Application and related Farm Impacts Analysis.

2003 - Current:

Consultation and project management for development projects requiring a thorough inventory and analysis of potential impacts on nearby and surrounding farm and forest lands. A sample of specific types of projects is as follows:

- Principal in charge of Plan Amendment, Zone Change and Site Plan for Expansion of Regional Landfill;
