Approval of Dust Control Plan and Odor Compendium

Dear Mr. O'Leary:

On January 27, 2014, Waste Management submitted a final Dust Control Plan and final Odor Control Compendium for Riverbend Landfill to DEQ for review and approval in accordance with Conditions 4.b. and 9.22, respectively. After internal DEQ review, DEQ hereby approves the two reports as submitted.

As outlined in the two reports certain operating and control practices must continue to be employed to reduce fugitive dust and odors from Riverbend Landfill operations. DEQ expects the control measures outlined in Table 1 of the Dust Control Plan to be continually implemented as applicable to the various sources of dust at the facility. In addition, the odor control strategies and best management practices outlined in Sections 1, 1.1, 1.2, and Appendix B must continue to be implemented on an ongoing basis to minimize odors from the landfill. The planned system enhancements shown in Section 1.2 that have not already been completed must be undertaken during the 2014 construction season and will hopefully lead to a further reduction in fugitive landfill gas emissions. In addition, if not already incorporated into the Odor Control Compendium, the Best Management Practices required by Condition 9.24 of the Title V permit must be maintained.

The operating and control practices outlined in the two documents or the existing Title V permit do not necessarily represent an end point in either dust or odor controls that could be employed at the facility. If Riverbend Landfill wishes to develop other new strategies, procedures, or controls, the facility must notify and receive approval from DEQ of such an intention in advance. If DEQ determines that additional controls or practices are necessary for either dust or odor control, we will notify Riverbend Landfill of any additional requirements.
