RE: Notice of Conditional Intent to Award
Yamhill County Rogers Landing County Park Aluminum Boarding Floats Project

On June 19, 2014 the Yamhill County Board of Commissioners adopted this Board Order #14- 341 "Notice of Conditional Intent to Award" for the "Yamhill County Rogers Landing County Park Aluminum Boarding Floats Project". The County received 4 bids, all of which came in above the original budgeted amount. However, rather than cancel the solicitation, the County is working with the Oregon State Marine Board (OSMB) in an effort to secure sufficient additional funding to allow us to accept and proceed to contracting with the lowest responsive, responsible bidder, CR Fabrication, Ltd., an Oregon corporation located at 833 SE 1st St, Redmond, Oregon 97756. The total basic bid for this project from CR Fabrication, Ltd. was \$317,974.88.

Contingent upon receiving sufficient additional funding from OSMB, Yamhill County's intention is to accept the total basic bid (\$317,974.88) plus decking Option #1 (\$34,569.60) for a total bid price of \$352,544.48

This memorandum constitutes Yamhill County's notice of its conditional intent to award the total basic bid and decking option #1 in the amount of \$352,544.48 to CR Fabrication, Ltd., 833 SE 1st St., Redmond, Oregon 97756.

Any protest of the conditional intent to award of this project must be filed with the Yamhill County Board of Commissioners at 434 NE Evans St, McMinnville, Oregon 97128 not later than 5 pm on Thursday June 26, 2014. Any protest of this conditional intent to award will be managed by the Board of Commissioners or its designee. Subject to receipt of sufficient additional funding from OSMB, if no protests are filed by the time stated, the Board will proceed to execute the contract for this project any time thereafter. If Yamhill County does not receive sufficient additional funding this solicitation will be canceled.
