**THIRD AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT**  
**(Yamhill County Department of Health and Human Services and**  
**Chehalem Youth and Family Services)**

THIS THIRD AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT ("**Amendment #3**") is made effective July 1, 2014, between **Yamhill County**, a political subdivision of the State of Oregon, acting by and through the Family and Youth Program of its Department of Health and Human Services and Board of Commissioners ("County") and **Chehalem Youth and Family Services**, an Oregon nonprofit corporation, 501 E. First Street, Newberg, Oregon, tax identification number 93-0386839 ("Contractor").

**RECITALS:**

A. County and Contractor are parties to that certain agreement dated as of November 10, 2011 (the "Underlying Agreement"), pursuant to which Contractor provides Mentoring Hub programs.

B. The Underlying Agreement was first amended October 17, 2012 (Amendment). The Underlying Agreement was again amended December 15, 2013 to include the 2013-2014 Scope of services and allocate additional funding for the 2013-2014 fiscal year. County and Contractor now desire to further amend the Underlying Agreement upon the terms and conditions as more particularly set forth herein below.

C. Capitalized terms not defined herein shall have the meanings attributed to such terms in the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements set forth herein below and of other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged by the parties hereto, County and Contractor, intending legally to be bound, hereby agree as follows:

1. Section 4 of the Underlying Agreement is hereby amended to allocate an additional maximum not to exceed amount of \$13,004.00 for the 2014-2015 fiscal year.

2. Section 6 of the Underlying Agreement is hereby amended to extend the term of the Underlying Agreement through August 31, 2014.

3. The balance of the Underlying Agreement remains unchanged.

4. Ratification. Except as otherwise expressly modified by the terms of this Amendment #3, the Underlying Agreement shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect. All terms, covenants and conditions of the Underlying Agreement not expressly modified herein are hereby confirmed and ratified and remain in full force and effect, and constitute valid and binding obligations of County and Contractor enforceable according to the terms thereof.

5. Authority. County and Contractor and each of the persons executing this Amendment #3 on behalf of County and Contractor hereby covenants and warrants that: (i) such party has full right and authority to enter into this Amendment #3 and has taken all action required to authorize such party (and each person executing this Amendment #3 on behalf of such party) to enter into this Amendment #3, and (ii) the person signing on behalf of such party is authorized to do so on behalf of such entity.

6. Binding Effect. All of the covenants contained in this Amendment #3 shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective heirs, legal representatives and permitted successors and assigns.

7. Counterparts. This Amendment #3 may be executed in multiple counterparts, each of which shall be an original, but all of which shall constitute one and the same Amendment #3.

8. Recitals. The foregoing recitals are intended to be a material part of this Amendment #3 and are incorporated herein by this reference.
