Agency Name	Funding Request	Brief Project Summary
Yamhill County	\$135,820.00	Funds are being requested for Phase II of III in an ongoing project to upgrade the current Public Safety Communications System. Phase I has begun and will replace the innermost links of the system, this was funded by YCOM and the City of McMinnville. Phase II will replace the microwave and public safety radio systems in three key areas throughout the county, see Appendix A. The funds will purchase: microwave dishes, radios and associated equipment required for on complete link (qty 3); channel banks and associated connectivity equipment required for one complete link (qty 3); system installation, test, and licensing services, microwave (qty 3); Interoperable Communications design and documentation (qty 1).
Newberg Police Department	\$203,750.00	The NPD is requesting to purchase 35 portable dual band radios which will create interoperability between Newberg-Dundee Police Department and Yamhill County Agencies for day-to-day and emergency operations. They currently utilize at Motorola 800 MHz radio while other Yamhill County Agencies and jurisdictions us a 450 MHz radio system. Requesting 35 radios and associated accessories.
Newberg Fire Department	\$184,175.00	The NFD is requesting to purchase 10 portable dual band radios which will create interoperability between Newberg Fire & EMS and Yamhill County Agencies for day-to-day and emergency operations. hey currently utilize at Motorola 800 MHz radio while other Yamhill County Agencies and jurisdictions us a 450 MHz radio system. Requesting 10 radios and associated accessories.
Carlton Police Department	\$20,000.00	CPD is requesting to outfit their newly acquired mobile command center (MCC). This will enhance the critical facility and allow the MCC to enhance their ability to respond in crisis situations. The grant will fund various material including: shredder/disintegrater, portable generator, extension cords, uninterruptible power UPS, medical supplices, portable radios, etc. There is currently not a MCC available in Carlton, this will greatly aide in CPD's ability to respond in emergency situations.
