**SIXTH AMENDMENT TO OREGON HEALTH AUTHORITY
2013-2015 INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR THE
FINANCING OF PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICES**

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This Sixth Amendment to Oregon Health Authority 2013-2015 Intergovernmental Agreement for the Financing of Public Health Services, effective July 1, 2013 (as amended the "Agreement"), is between the State of Oregon acting by and through its Oregon Health Authority ("OHA") and Yamhill County, acting by and through its Yamhill County Public Health ("LPHA"), the entity designated, pursuant to ORS 431.375(2), as the Local Public Health Authority for Yamhill County.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, OHA and LPHA wish to modify the Financial Assistance Award set forth in Exhibit C of the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, covenants and agreements contained herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto agree as follows.

AGREEMENT

1. Section 1 of Exhibit C entitled "Financial Assistance Award" of the Agreement is hereby superseded and replaced in its entirety by Exhibit 1 attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.
2. LPHA represents and warrants to OHA that the representations and warranties of LPHA set forth in Section 2 of Exhibit E of the Agreement are true and correct on the date hereof with the same effect as if made on the date hereof.
3. Capitalized words and phrases used but not defined herein shall have the meanings ascribed thereto in the Agreement.
4. Except as amended hereby, all terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect.

5. The parties affirm and ratify the Agreement as herein amended.
6. This Amendment may be executed in any number of counterparts, all of which when taken together shall constitute one agreement binding on all parties, notwithstanding that all parties are not signatories to the same counterpart. - d) Immunization Special Payments are funded by State General Fund and matched dollar for dollar with Medicaid.
- e) Funding formula base increase (\$12,000 per SBHC) for counties with more than one certified SBHC, due to passing of HB2445.
