THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF YAMHILL COUNTY, OREGON ("the Board") sat for the transaction of County business in formal session on Thursday, October 30, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. in Room 32 of the courthouse, Commissioners Allen Springer, Kathy George and Mary Starrett being present.

THE BOARD MAKES THE FOLLOWING FINDINGS:

WHEREAS, SW Bayou Drive is a publicly dedicated local access road in Yamhill County, Oregon, near the City of McMinnville. SW Bayou Drive has not historically been maintained by the Yamhill County Department of Public Works.

WHEREAS, earlier this year, on February 13, 2014, the Board adopted Board Order 14-85 to initiate the vacation of a portion of SW Bayou Drive and, on March 27, 2014, the Board held a public hearing to take testimony with regard to (i) the acquisition of property adjacent to existing Bayou Drive and (ii) the vacation of a portion of existing SW Bayou Drive.

WHEREAS, pursuant to ORS 368.031(2), a county governing body shall spend county moneys on a local access road only if the governing body determines that the work is an emergency or if (a) the county road official recommends the expenditure, (b) the public use of the road justifies the expenditure proposed or (c) the county governing body enacts an order or resolution authorizing the work and designating the work to be either a single project or a continuing program

WHEREAS, the Road Director for Yamhill County has come before the Board on this date and recommended the expenditure of county moneys on SW Bayou Drive to address ongoing safety risks to the general public and to vehicular traffic in the public dedicated right of way (ROW), including but not limited to: (a) travel lanes that are narrower than the minimum allowed under current County road standards, (b) unauthorized parking spaces located within the ROW, and (c) permanent obstructions placed in the ROW.

WHEREAS, the Board finds that the public use of SW Bayou Drive justifies the proposed expenditures, NOW THEREFORE,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE BOARD AS FOLLOWS:

Pursuant to ORS 368.031, the Yamhill County Department of Public Works is hereby authorized to perform work on SW Bayou Drive and to expend County moneys on such work as is deemed necessary by the Yamhill County Department of Public Works to address the safety risks described herein; this work is hereby designated as a continuing program.
