Re: Reappoint Tex Rhodes to SWAC for 3 year term

Tex Rhodes' term on the Yamhill County Solid Waste Advisory Committee (SWAC) expires on March 15, 2015. Tex fills the position of 1.e.A of ORS 459.320 which states: "Local organizations and citizen interest groups whose majority of members either: (A) are electors of the county in which the regional disposal site is located; or (B) Own real property in the county in which the regional disposal site is located.

Tex is a member of the Chehalem Valley Chamber of Commerce through working for SP Fiber Technologies (SPFT). Most of the employees of SPFT and members of the Chamber of Commerce are electors of the county in which the regional disposal site is located AND most own real property in the county in which the regional disposal site is located.

Mr. Rhodes is willing to serve another three-year term on the SWAC.
Staff recommends his reappointment based on his conscientious participation in the past.

ACTION:

The Board will decide whether to reappoint Tex Rhodes for another three year term on the SWAC (staff's recommendation), or advertise the opening and interview applicants.

*In January 2012, the Solid Waste Department advertised a SWAC opening. The ad ran four weeks and received one application. The application is on file.

Re: SWAC Position

Bill Carr's term on the Yamhill County Solid Waste Advisory Committee (SWAC) will expire on March 15, 2015. Due to management changes within the company, Bill Carr recommends this position be filled with the new District Operations Manager of Riverbend Landfill, David Adler.

ORS 459.320 states: "The Board shall select members of the committee from among at least each of the following groups, to the extent feasible: (1.d) Employees of the permittee ('permittee' is defined in ORS 459.315 as a person operating a regional disposal site under a permit issued under ORS 459.245.)"

David Adler holds a position with the company that represents Waste Management.

ACTION:

The Board can appoint David Adler to a three year term on the SWAC (staff's recommendation), or ask Waste Management to select other candidates for this position.
