Hi Mary and Laura,

I am requesting permission to apply for a Specialty Court grant administered by the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission. This grant is for our Women's Recovery Court to assist clients in successfully accomplishing drug court requirements and parenting their children while living a clean and sober, crime-free life in the community. The grant request will be for approximately \$135,000 for the 2015-2017 biennium with an official start date of 7/1/15. Our current grant ends on 6/30/15. If awarded, the grant will include payments to Provoking Hope for recovery mentor support, as well as fund .3 full time equivalent position of an Adult Parole and Probation officer within Community Justice.

If our grant application is successful, I will return to the Board to request ratification for the actual amount awarded. The HHS 2015-2016 Adopt budget will be adjusted to include this amount.
