THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF YAMHILL COUNTY, OREGON ("the Board") sat for the transaction of County business in formal session on Thursday, June 25, 2015 at 10:00 a.m. in Room 32 of the courthouse, Commissioners Allen Springer, Mary Starrett, and Stan Primozich being present.

WHEREAS, Yamhill County desires to protect its Search and Rescue (SAR) volunteers, Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) service workers, and volunteer board members, volunteer commission members and volunteer public officials performing work for the County from injuries arising out of or in the scope of their service to the County, pursuant to ORS 656.031; and

WHEREAS, the Board elects to affirm its commitment to same, workers' compensation for said volunteers will be established as follows:

1. An assumed monthly wage of \$800.00 will be used for public safety volunteers, and specifically:
 - Yamhill County Search and Rescue;
 - Community Emergency Response Team (CERT);
2. An aggregate assumed annual wage of \$2,500 will be used per volunteer board, volunteer commission and/or council for the performance of administrative duties; and
3. An assumed monthly wage of \$800 per month will be used for volunteer public officials for the performance of manual labor above and beyond the administrative duties coverage by paragraph 2 above, and
4. A roster of active SAR and CERT volunteers will be kept monthly for reporting purposes; it is acknowledged that the insurance provider may request copies of these rosters during year-end audit; and
5. Unanticipated volunteer projects or exposure not addressed herein will be added onto Yamhill County's coverage agreement (1) by endorsement, (2) with advance notice to CIS, and (3) allowing two weeks for processing. It is hereby acknowledged that coverage of this type cannot be backdated.

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- 6. County volunteers other than those expressly mentioned above will not be covered under the County's workers compensation policy.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS that worker's compensation insurance coverage will be provided as listed above, and that this resolution will be updated annually.
