THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF YAMHILL COUNTY, OREGON (the Board) sat for the transaction of county business on October 8, 2015, Commissioners Allen Springer, Mary Starrett and Stan Primozych being present.

IT APPEARING TO THE BOARD that on April 30, 2015, the Board adopted Ordinance 891, a plan amendment and zone change for a portion of Tax Lot 3315-3800, to allow a vineyard located on the property to be partitioned from the home. That decision was appealed to LUBA. On July 22, 2015, at the request of the applicant, the Board withdrew its decision to adopt Ordinance 891, for reconsideration. On September 16, 2015 the applicant formally withdrew his application for a plan amendment/zone change. NOW, THEREFORE

THE BOARD ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance 891 is hereby repealed.

Section 2. This Ordinance being necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Yamhill County, and an emergency having been declared to exist, is effective immediately.
