Hi Mary and Laura,

I would like to request the Board's permission to apply for Problem Gambling (PG) Outreach and Awareness Grant funding from the Oregon Health Authority (OHA). If approved, the grant request will be for \$20,000 and must be utilized by December 31, 2017. If awarded, the grant would fund problem gambling outreach aimed at increasing awareness of problem gambling in the adult population, and the availability of treatment for the problem gambler and their loved ones at the community level. While this grant was not included in our Adopted 2016-2017 budget, we have the expense authority.

The target population for these funds will be adults at risk for problem gambling. We will administer the program through our Public Health Division's health promotion team.

If our grant application is successful, I will return to the Board to request approval for the amount awarded.
