Hi Commissioner Olson,

I wanted to follow up with you after our conversation in The Dalles about our AOC staffing request related to Ian.

For a limited period of two months, we would like to have Ian step in to help with our AOC-LOC-OHCS Housing Partnership project. This help would consist of 25% of Ian's time; during these two months, 25% of Ian's salary would not come out of the LPSCC grant, but instead would come from OHCS grant funds. The main piece of Ian's work would be to help support 8 Housing Workshops that are going to be held across Oregon in the next few months. The need for his help is the recent departure of Evyn Mitchell from AOC.

In talking with Ian, he believes this scenario is doable for this limited period. We have consulted with Commissioner Pope in Polk County and he is supportive of this approach.

Please let me know if this will work for Yamhill County.
