Declare YCTA vehicles surplus	Declare two (2) buses surplus and authorize public works to sell according to County procedures. And remove from the surplus list one (1) bus that was declared surplus on August 30, 2018.

Background Info:

The following buses are beyond their useful life according to state and federal standards. One bus declared previously will be kept as reserve bus until next round of new buses arrive.

The buses will be prepared for auction according to County policies and procedures. The buses owned by the State will need to be released and titles returned. The request has been submitted to the state and once the paperwork is received the Transit Manager will inform Public Works, so they can proceed with the sale.
