Dear Commissioners:

On behalf of the Sheriff's Office, I would like to request approval to submit a grant application to the Firehouse Subs Public Safety Foundation, which is due on Thursday, November 29, 2018. The application requests \$24,500 to replace expiring bulletproof vests for patrol and corrections deputies.

Bulletproof vests are warrantied for five years, and each vest set costs \$875. The proposed application will provide 28 vests, for a total of \$24,500. There is no match requirement for this grant program.

In 2015, the SO was awarded a grant through the Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) for the replacement of 12 bulletproof vests. Unfortunately, BJA funds are available only to counties with populations of less than 100,000 and Yamhill County is no longer eligible to apply.

With this in mind, we are asking for your approval to submit this application for funding. Please let us know if you have questions.
