

**AMENDMENT NO. 4 TO
PROFESSIONAL SERVICE AGREEMENT
(Sex Offender Treatment/Individual Therapy/
Group and Family Counseling)**

THIS AMENDMENT NO. 4 ("Amendment #4") shall be made effective as of July 1, 2019, by and between **Yamhill County**, a political subdivision of the State of Oregon, acting through the Juvenile Division of its Department of Community Justice ("DCJ") and **Higher Ground Counseling, Inc.**, an Oregon corporation, located at 2505 Portland Road, Suite 202B, Newberg, Oregon, 97132 ("Contractor").

RECITALS

A. County and Contractor are parties to that certain contract dated December 13, 2016 (the "Underlying Contract"), pursuant to which Contractor provides County with sex offender treatment services, as further described in the Underlying Contract. The Underlying Contract is memorialized in Yamhill County records as Board Order 16-482. The Underlying Contract was first amended on June 1, 2017, memorialized as Board Order 17-177 and further amended on December 21, 2017, memorialized as Board Order 17-512 and again on July 12, 2018, memorialized as Board Order 18-249.

B. County and Contractor now desires to further modify the Underlying Contract upon the terms and conditions more particularly set forth herein below.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements set forth herein below and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

1. Section 1 of the Underlying Contract is hereby amended to extend the Underlying Contract from July 1, 2019, through June 30, 2020, unless terminated in accordance with Section 5 of the Underlying Contract. Upon the conclusion of this next term this Underlying Contract will automatically be renewed on a year-by-year basis, under the same terms and conditions as set forth herein, unless modified in writing signed by both parties or terminated in accordance with the Section 5 of the Underlying Contract.

2. Section 4 of the Underlying Contract is hereby amended to limit the maximum amount the County could pay under the Underlying Contract to \$25,000.00 per fiscal year. The balance of Section 4 remains unchanged.

2. Ratification. Except as otherwise expressly modified by the terms of this Amendment #4, the Underlying Contract shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect. All terms, covenants and conditions of the Underlying Contract not expressly modified herein are hereby confirmed and ratified and remain in full force and effect, and constitute valid and binding obligations of County and Contractor enforceable according to the terms thereof.

3. Authority. County and Contractor and each of the persons executing this Amendment #4 on behalf of County and Contractor hereby covenants and warrants that: (i) such party has full right and authority to enter into this Amendment #4 and has taken all action required to authorize such party (and each person executing this Amendment #4 on behalf of such party) to enter into this Amendment #4, and (ii) the person signing on behalf of such party is authorized to do so on behalf of such entity.

4. Binding Effect. All of the covenants contained in this Amendment #4 shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective heirs, legal representatives and permitted successors and assigns.

5. Counterparts. This Amendment #4 may be executed in multiple counterparts, each of which shall be an original, but all of which shall constitute one and the same Amendment #4.
6. Recitals. The foregoing recitals are intended to be a material part of this Amendment #4 and are incorporated herein by this reference.
