I would like to request Board Consideration to declare an ambulance surplus, so that we can donate it to Provoking Hope to be used for the syringe exchange program. The ambulance was donated by the City of McMinnville, and accepted by the Board on 6/6/2019 via B.O 19-173, for the purpose of implementing the syringe exchange program.

If approved, Provoking Hope will maintain and insure the vehicle and use it as outlined for services in the contract approved on 8/1/19 via B.O. 19-277. The estimated value of the ambulance is \$13,100.
