I would like permission to apply for funding under the Public Health Division's Overdose Prevention Project. The amount of funding awarded will be determined by the number of interested Local Public Health Authorities or regions requesting funds. Funding will be non-competitive and project based to offer flexibility to choose from a menu of required and optional activities.

If our application is successful, this funding will continue and expand the work we are doing under the current Prescription Drug Overdose grant in collaboration with Polk and Marion Counties. Our current funding ends June 30, 2020. This funding will be awarded in our Local Public Health Authority Agreement.
