I would like approval to submit an application for a Distance Learning & Telemedicine Grant from the US Department of Agriculture, Rural Development, Rural Utilities Service. The maximum available per application is \$1,000,000.

If our application is successful, funds will be utilized to strengthen our health care providers' ability to provide connected care services to clients at their homes or mobile locations in response to the novel Coronavirus 2019 disease (COVID-19) pandemic. This includes the purchase of telecommunication services, information services, and devices necessary to provide critical connected care services via a telehealth platform within our electronic health record.

This grant would be in addition to the previously approved to submit grant request to support telehealth.
