Hi Mary and Ken,

I would like permission to apply for \$15,000 in funding from Oregon Health Sciences University, Oregon Center for Children and Youth with Special Needs (OCCYSHN). While this amount is not specifically included in our Health and Human Services 2020-2021 Adopted Budget, we have sufficient budget authority to receive the funds if awarded.

If our application is successful, the funds will be used to pilot the use of Activate Care (formerly ACT.md), an online care coordination platform for a small number of families who participate in our voluntary CaCoon program. We will meet virtually once a month with other public health departments using the platform to share and learn. Activate care will allow us to create, update, and track shared care plans in an online format accessible to families, youth, providers, and other professionals involved in the shared care planning process.

The COVID-19 pandemic shifted the way we coordinate care for children and youth with special health needs. This unique opportunity will allow us to explore another option to maintain communication and coordinate care in a virtual environment.
