WHEREAS, the County of Yamhill on the 9th day of September, 2020, has:

- X Suffered widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life and/or property
- X Determined there is imminent threat of widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life and/or property

Resulting from Chehalem Mountain Fire and Henry Hagg Lake Fire and impacting multiple areas Yamhill County.

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that extraordinary measures in the form of additional county resources are needed to respond to these wildfire emergencies, to protect the public and to keep it as safe as possible. Resources related to continuity of operations, public information, issuance of evacuation orders, and the potential of funding is expected to be exhausted; and;

WHEREAS, Yamhill County Ordinance 883 serves as a basis for an emergency declaration and emergency control in the public's interest, including implementation of the Yamhill County Emergency Operations Plan; NOW THEREFORE,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED by the Board of Commissioners of Yamhill County:

1. In accordance with Ordinance 883, a "State of Emergency" is hereby declared within Yamhill County.
2. That the Emergency Operations Plan has been implemented and the EOC is activated.
3. That the Oregon Revised Statutes regarding Powers of Local Governments in Emergency Service procedures and Ordinance 883 provide the bases for invoking this Emergency Declaration, which shall continue until September 30, 2020 unless extended or earlier terminated by further action of the Yamhill County Board of Commissioners.
4. That this board order and resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
