Good Morning Commissioners,

Dan Armstrong, I was hoping to be with you this morning to encourage you to fill the vacancy in the Yamhill County Planning Commission.

As you will recall, to fill our previous vacancy a couple months ago, the Planning Department received nineteen applications which we commissioners ranked one through nineteen. Director Friday tabulated the results and invited the top six to be interviewed by the Planning Commissioners which we did and then ranked the applicants again. That ranked list of applicants was submitted to the Board and you selected the number one applicant and appointed him to the Planning Commission.

Shortly thereafter, another member of the Planning Commission resigned. Please fill this vacancy. I suggest you select the next ranked applicant from the list of six the Planning Commission submitted to you.

The Planning Commission's work in ranking applicants and then interviewing the top six was very thorough; all members asked questions of each candidate and we had a thoughtful discussion prior to ranking them. It was a process unlike any other I have seen in my ten years on the Planning Commission. I don't know how we could have done better.
