**Re:** Criminal Justice Commission (CJC) Justice Reinvestment (JRI) Supplemental Funding Round for the 2021-23 Biennium

On 10/31/22, the Criminal Justice Commission released the Supplemental Funding Round for the 2021-2023 Justice Reinvestment Grant Program. These funds are derived from underspent and unallocated Justice Reinvestment Funds throughout the state and will be awarded through a competitive process pursuant to Oregon Administrative Rule 213-060-0080. Approximately \$350,000 of funding is available and all Oregon counties are eligible to apply.

Yamhill County is requesting Board approval to apply for a total of \$36,300.00 to be used through 12/31/23 for staff training of Pretrial Justice and Adult Recovery Court staff through the National Association of Pretrial Agencies (NAPSA) and National Association of Drug Court Professionals (NADCP) Conferences, provide critical housing resources for the Justice Involved Individuals we serve as well as administrative costs and additional victim's services support through Juliette's House. Currently, the Department of Corrections (DOC) Community Corrections 2023-25 biennial funding, for which YCDCJ is mainly supported, is uncertain and expected to decrease compared to the previous biennium due to a variety of reasons. These additional funds would provide for continued training and resources that may not otherwise be supported through traditional DOC Grant-In-Aid in the 2023-25 biennium. If awarded, these funds will be added to Yamhill County's Formula Justice Reinvestment Grant Award.

The grant application is due December 1<sup>st</sup> at noon.
