Hi Mary and Ken,

Attached is amendment #4 to the Provider Services agreement between Yamhill County with Yamhill Community Care Organization (YCCO) (BO 20-457) retroactive to July 1, 2023. The amendment increases the funding amount for school-based services. While this additional amount is not included in our Health and Human Services 2023-2024 Budget, we have sufficient budget authority.

Considering that this amendment increases the funding for additional school-based services, we would like to request the following changes to the current position management authority within the HHS Family and Youth Division (Div. 75):

- Add 1.4 FTE HS Spec 3 (40624) for QMHP (an additional 1 FTE is included in funding but is intended as pass through for a contracted provider).

I recommend the Board approve this amendment as written and request for additional position management authority. Please let me know if you have any questions.
