Attached, please find the grant application for the FY2023 – 2024 Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) to be submitted by our Emergency Management unit. In a change from prior years, we are only submitting a matching funds amount equal to the expect award amount, rather than submitting the full program amount for matching/total project funds. This will prevent us from having to make adjustments to the grant documents post-award.

The expected award from the state will cover approximately 38% of the total personnel costs for the Emergency Manager position (including roll-ups). This is a reduction of 12% from the FY22-23 award amount / FY23-24 EM budgeted revenue from OEM. We will cover the remaining personnel and materials and services expenses for the EM unit from discretionary allocation and carry forward from prior fiscal years.

Proposed agenda language:

*Approval of grant application for the Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) through the Oregon Office of Emergency Management for the FY2023 – 2024 grant period in the amount of \$78,315.00.*

This submission is due by July 24<sup>th</sup>, so we request this item be placed on the agenda for July 13<sup>th</sup> for the Board's consideration.
