Dear Mayor Rosacker and Newberg City Council,

DCI will be requesting an extension of their temporary zoning allowance to enable them to continue operations at 1150 N. Springbrook Road. The devastating fire that occurred at DCI's corporate headquarters in April of 2022 was a tragedy that warranted, and still warrants, continued support from the County and City. The County Commissioners stood shoulder-to-shoulder with the City of Newberg only days after the event to find a swift emergency resolution that would give DCI a chance at recovery. What was accomplished to grant DCI zoning allowance was an act of civic responsibility to our mutual constituents that we remain proud of to this day. Not only has DCI's business been able to rebound quickly, but it has continued to allow them to participate in community-based endeavors that make Newberg and Yamhill County a better place to live for our residents. DCI has pledged its commitment to rebuilding their corporate headquarters in Yamhill County. Their request for temporary zoning extension seems reasonable given the severity of the event and the time it takes to settle their insurance claim, acquire property, and develop a new facility.

We fully support DCI's request for extension of their temporary zoning allowance. Let us continue to support a business that supports our community and its families.
