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RESOLUTION 19-04-18-1

WHEREAS, the National Day of Prayer is a tradition first proclaimed by the Continental Congress in 1775; and

WHEREAS, in 1988, Legislation setting aside the first Thursday in May each year as a National Day of Prayer was passed unanimously by both houses of Congress and signed by President Ronald Reagan; and

WHEREAS, Congress has declared May 2, 2019, as the official observance of the National Day of Prayer; and

WHEREAS, the National Day of Prayer is an opportunity for Americans of all faiths to join in united prayer to give thanks for blessings received, to request healing for wounds endured, to ask for guidance for our leaders and bring wholeness to the United States and her citizens; and

WHEREAS, the National Day of Prayer is an opportunity for Americans to pray for what they feel is important for the City, the County, the State, this Country and the World in total; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Yamhill County Board of Commissioners do hereby proclaim May 2, 2019 as:

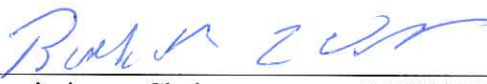
NATIONAL DAY OF PRAYER

To encourage citizens to join in prayer, asking for guidance and strength for our people and our leaders so that we may meet the challenges that lie before us with courage, wisdom and justice.

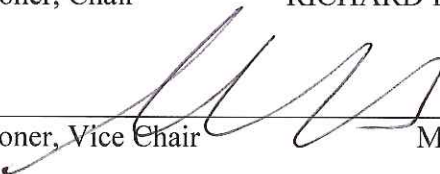

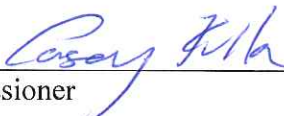
