WHEREAS, manufacturing companies significantly contribute to national, state, and local economies and are celebrated annually on the first Friday in October with Manufacturing Day and Yamhill County celebrates manufacturing career exploration through organizing a Manufacturing Week the first week of October; and

WHEREAS, in 2022, the manufacturing sector generated \$36.21 billion in output employing approximately 192,100 people in Oregon with an average annual salary of \$91,467; and

WHEREAS, the Oregon Employment Department forecasts a 7% growth in the state's manufacturing sector from 2022 to 2032, with the primary metals manufacturing sector anticipated to grow the fastest at 19%; and

WHEREAS, Yamhill County boasts outstanding manufacturing companies that produce a diverse range of products, with a total of 360 manufacturers throughout Yamhill County; and

WHEREAS, these companies add to the vitality and prosperity of our community by employing 5,786 employees throughout Yamhill County; and

WHEREAS, manufacturing has a revenue impact of nearly \$956M throughout Yamhill County.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved that the Yamhill County Board of Commissioners, on behalf of the citizens of Yamhill County, hereby recognizes October 4, 2024, as Manufacturing Day in Yamhill County, and in doing so, encourages our community to support local manufacturing, pursue careers in manufacturing and to buy products made in Yamhill County.
