WHEREAS, it appears to the Board that a petition signed by Berneta B. Hunt has been filed with the Yamhill County Department of Planning and Development requesting that County Road #102 be named Hillside Drive, and

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD that said petition be and hereby is accepted by the Board and a public hearing shall be held on the said petition at 10:00 o'clock a.m. on the 14th day of February, 1979, in Room 105 of the Yamhill County Courthouse in McMinnville, Oregon.

IT IS FURTHER HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD that the Yamhill County Planning Director shall refer said petition for advice and comment to any Federal, State, or Local Jurisdictions as deemed appropriate and in accordance with Ordinance No. 110.

IT IS FURTHER HEREBY RESOLVED that the County Office Engineer shall post notice of the public hearing to be held in three of the most public and conspicuous places on County Road #102, at least 10 days before the date set for said hearing.

IT IS FURTHER HEREBY RESOLVED that all persons interested may appear at the public hearing in favor of or against said proposed road naming, and an opportunity will be given all to be heard.




Beginning at the centerline intersection of Market Road No. 4 and County Road No. 102 in the North ½ of Section 11, Township 3 South, Range 3 West, Willamette Meridian; thence Northerly and Easterly through Section 2 and 1 of said Township and Range; thence Northeasterly through Sections 35 and 36 of Township 2 South, Range 3 West, Willamette Meridian to the centerline intersection of County Road No. 67 and County Road No. 102 in said Section 36, said intersection being the terminus of said County Road No. 102, and being approximately 2.27 miles in length.
The proposed road name is "HILLSIDE DRIVE".
