WHEREAS, Vietnamese refugees have proudly resided in the county of Yamhill, the state of Oregon since the conclusion of the Vietnam War on April 30, 1975; and

WHEREAS, Vietnamese Americans have put forth their full toiling energy building the county of Yamhill, the state of Oregon in a multitude of prominent areas including industry, economy, culture, education, and military service; and

WHEREAS, Vietnamese Americans have counted on the State of Oregon as being their second heart, mind, and family homeland; and

WHEREAS, Every year, Vietnamese Americans celebrate Remembrance Day on April 30th to solemnly honor the 58,000 American soldiers that included 810 Servicemen and Servicewomen from state of Oregon, and more than 300,000 South Vietnamese soldiers who sacrificed their lives in the line of duty for freedom and democracy in South Vietnam from November 1955 to April 1975.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved that the Yamhill County Board of Commissioners, on behalf of the citizens of Yamhill County, hereby recognizes April 30, 2025 as Vietnamese-American Remembrance Day and we resolutely encourage all to join in the reverent recognition of this cultural heritage celebration.
