VACATION SELL-BACK REQUEST (FOPPO ONLY)**

I desire to sell back (or “cash in”) to Yamhill County \_\_\_\_\_ hours of accrued vacation or other authorized leave (except sick leave). I understand that hours sold back will be paid in cash as wages based on my existing salary level. I understand that payment will be made as part of my regular paycheck. I will elect, in a space below, which pay period to take payment.

I understand that this request is allowed once each fiscal year and is subject to the following:

1. An employee must have at least one year of continuous service with Yamhill County to be eligible for this benefit.
2. An employee with at least one year of continuous service may sell back up to 40 hours (one week) accrued vacation or authorized leave (except sick leave). This option may be exercised once per fiscal year.
3. In conjunction with the vacation buy-back, an employee must also take 40 hours (one week) five continuous days of vacation which may include a holiday or other authorized leave (except sick leave).

The terms of this procedure are set forth in the collective bargaining agreement between the county and FOPPO. If the collective bargaining agreement is changed, this procedure may be modified.
