

YAMHILL COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

SPECIAL FORMAL SESSION

October 26, 2015 3:00 p.m. Commissioners' Office Conference Room

Commissioner Springer called the meeting to order at 3:02 p.m.

1. Consideration of an appeal of a disciplinary action.

County Counsel, Christian Boenisch explained that the reason for the special formal session is to consider the appeal of Murray Paolo's termination of employment with Yamhill County as Information Technology Manager, effective October 12, 2015. He stated that the Board of Commissioners have three options: 1.) affirm the decision to terminate Mr. Paolo's employment, 2.) reverse the decision to terminate Mr. Paolo's employment and reinstate him to his former position, or 3.) reduce the level of discipline which could include somewhat of reinstatement of county employment.

Commissioner Springer, Starrett and Primozich stated they individually read and studied in detail all the written material provided to them. Commissioner Starrett moved approval to uphold and affirm the decision of the County Administrator. Commissioner Primozich seconded the motion. The motion passed, Commissioners Springer, Starrett and Primozich voting aye.
